REGULAR MEETING.

SAN JOSE, June 6th, 1864.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of San Jose held their regular meeting this evening. Mayor Quinby presiding. Present, Aids. Bonner, Cory, Hobson, Magenheimer, Porter and Pomeroy.

The minutes of the preceding meeting were read and approved.

A petition was received from the property owners on St. John street, between First and Third streets, requesting the privilege of grading, graveling and curbing said portion of St. John street. On motion, Mr. A. D. Fuller, surveyor, was instructed to make the necessary survey, plan, specifications and estimates for the proposed improvements, and the Ordinance Committee directed to report an ordinance granting the prayer of petitioners.

The committee to whom was referred the petition of Mr. D. McKenzie in relation to erecting water works, reported favorably upon the same, and recommended that the Ordinance Committee be instructed to report an ordinance granting the prayer of the petitioner. On motion, the report was received and adopted.
