closing the same shall be specified in the call for the meeting; and if at said meeting this act shall be so accepted, then said borough may proceed at the same meeting to vote upon the matter of issuing said notes, bonds or certificates, and to elect said commissioners and treasurer of the water fund, and to transact any other business contemplated in the provisions of this act; *provided*, notice thereof shall have been inserted in the call for said meeting.

SEC. 14. This act shall take effect from the day of its acceptance, as above, by said borough of Danbury, and may be altered, amended or repealed by the general assembly.

AMENDING "AN ACT TO SUPPLY THE BOROUGH OF NEW BRITAIN
WITH WATER FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PURPOSES."

Resolved by this Assembly:—SEC. 1. That the warden, burgesses and freemen of the borough of New Britain, be, and they hereby are, authorized and empowered to extend and continue their water pipes to localities without the limits of said borough, and within the town of New Britain, and to supply and distribute water by them taken under the provision of said act, to the proprietors or occupants of such localities, upon such terms as may be agreed upon between said proprietors or occupants and the proper officers of said borough; and all the powers and privileges conferred upon said borough by said act, shall apply to this act, so far as may be necessary to make the same fully effectual for the purposes aforesaid; *provided*, that this act may be altered, amended or repealed at the pleasure of the general assembly.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from the day of its passage.
