CHAPTER XIII.

An Act relating to the City of New Haven.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened :

City of New Haven may become stockholders, &c. in New Haven Water Company, and may contract with said Company.

SEC. 1. That the mayor, aldermen and common council and freemen of the city of New Haven, be authorized and empowered to become stockholders, by subscription or otherwise, in the "New Haven Water Company," and to make such contract with said "New Haven Water Company" for the supply of the said city with water for the extinguishment of fire, or for any other purpose, as by said city shall be deemed expedient.

This act not to take effect until approved in city meeting.

SEC. 2. This act shall not take effect, until the same shall be approved of by the said mayor, aldermen and common council and freemen of said city in a city meeting legally warned and held for that purpose.

Approved, June 24th, 1852.

CHAPTER XIV.

An Act authorizing the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of the City of New Haven to pass by-laws for protecting said city from damage by fire.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened :

Court of common council of city of New Haven, may pass by-laws for protecting said city from fire.

That the mayor, aldermen and common council of the city of New Haven, in common council convened, be, and they are hereby authorized to pass by-laws for protecting said city from damage by fire.
