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hereby are authorized to increase their capital stock, so that the same shall not exceed five hundred thousand dollars in the whole, including the stock already authorized and issued, by adding to said stock already issued, two hundred thousand dollars; and that they be and hereby are authorized, by their directors or otherwise, to cause the same to be issued at such time or times, and in such manner, as they may deem expedient.

### Amending the Charter of the Litchfield Female Academy.

*Resolved by this Assembly*, SEC. 1. That there shall be a meeting of the Litchfield Female Academy for the election of trustees of said academy, and for the transaction of any other proper business, to be held at the office of H. W. Buell, in said Litchfield, on the sixth day of July, 1863, at two o'clock in the afternoon, notice thereof to be given by said Buell, by publishing, over his signature, a call therefor in the Litchfield Enquirer, a paper published in said Litchfield, at least one week previous to said sixth day of July, 1863.

SEC. 2. The trustees elected in pursuance of this resolution, shall have the same powers as are conferred by the act incorporating said academy, except that they shall be elected annually, as provided by resolution, passed May session, A. D. 1854, amending said charter; and the acts and proceedings of said meeting shall be as valid as if annual meetings of said corporation had been held.

### Annexing certain Real Estate of Solomon Porter to the South-East School District of East Hartford.

Upon the petition of Sidney Hills, *et al.*, of the South-East School District of East Hartford, asking for increase of territory:

*Resolved by this Assembly*, That the house now owned by Solomon Porter, situate in the territory described in said petition, together with its present and future occupants, be and they are hereby annexed to the South-East School District of East Hartford, in the county of Hartford.

### Amending the Charter of the New Haven Water Company.

*Resolved by this Assembly*, That the New Haven Water Company be and they are hereby authorized to issue bonds to the amount of two hundred thousand dollars, including those already issued, that being one-half the amount already expended by said company on their works; and that the charter of said company be amended accordingly.
