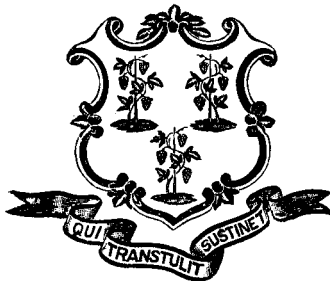

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE FUNERAL EXPENSES OF JAMES J. QUINN.

Resolved by this Assembly: That, whenever the selectmen of the town of Vernon shall have presented to the acting quartermaster-general such evidence as they possess concerning the military service and the death and burial of the late James J. Quinn, a soldier who served in Company C, First Regiment, Connecticut Volunteers, in the Spanish-American war, and in accordance with the form prescribed by the acting quartermaster-general in similar cases, so far as the same may be applicable, the acting quartermaster-general is hereby directed to certify to the comptroller that said evidence has been presented, and the comptroller shall thereupon draw his order on the treasurer in favor of the selectmen of said town of Vernon for the sum of thirty-five dollars for the funeral expenses of said James J. Quinn.

GRANTING A DIVORCE TO SUSAN CHREST OF NORWICH.

Resolved by this Assembly: That the marriage relation heretofore existing between Susan Chrest, of Norwich, and Frank H. Chrest, of Middletown, is hereby dissolved, and the said Susan Chrest is hereby divorced and declared to be sole, single, and unmarried; provided, however, that before this resolution shall take effect the said Susan Chrest shall cause a copy of this resolution to be recorded in full upon the records of the town clerk of said town of Norwich.

AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE NEW HAVEN WATER COMPANY.

Resolved by this Assembly: That the New Haven Water Company is hereby authorized to lay its mains and supply water for public and domestic use in the towns of Bethany, Woodbridge, Cheshire, Hamden, North Haven, Prospect, North Branford, Milford, and Branford; provided, however, that if any other corporation, public or private, shall be lawfully engaged in supplying water to any one of such towns or its inhabitants, said New Haven Water Company may lay mains and supply water in such town only with the written consent of such corporation engaged in supplying water to said town or its inhabitants.
