And that there is a valuable Spring
situated a small distance West of said
Town which by proper Aqua Ducts might
be brought into the Centre of said Town
and abundantly supply the Inhabitants
with good, fresh, pure Water - And also
supply the shipping in said Harbour -
And that of our Petitioners have entered
into a Company or Association for the
purpose of supplying ^{sd} Inhabitants
with Water, by Pipes - from said Mountain
provided they can be incorporated for
that purpose, & be vested in the exclusive
right of providing Water by Pipes as

as aforesaid -

Whereas on the 17th day of
 Honour to incorporate them and their
 Associates in to a Company by the Name
 of the Proprietors of the Aqueduct at
 South end on, with ~~full~~ the exclusive
 Right of supplying the Inhabitants of
 the City of New London, ~~supplying~~ ^{at the} Wells at the
 Port of South end on, and the Wharves at
 said Port with Fresh Water, by Pipes
 or Ducts as aforesaid - and also with
 power to regulate the same, & make
 just bye Laws relative thereto, as
 may be found necessary - with power
 also of laying a ~~reasonable~~ ^{reasonable} Tax or
 Duty on all such persons as
 may use the same, either by the Year
 or for a shorter term - and they do in
