Authorizing Increase of Capital of the New Britain Gas Light Company.

Resolved by this Assembly: That the New Britain Gas Light Company be authorized to increase their capital to an amount not exceeding two hundred thousand dollars.

Approved, June 6, 1871.

Authorizing the Travelers Insurance Company to accept and file acceptance of Amendments to its Charter.

Resolved by this Assembly: That the Travelers Insurance Company of Hartford be, and is hereby, authorized to accept and to file for record in the office of the secretary of state its acceptance of the amendments heretofore passed to its charter, and all acts of said company which have been done in pursuance of and by the authority of said amendments are hereby validated and confirmed, as if said acceptance had been made and filed within the time specified by law.

Approved, June 6, 1871.

An Act in Addition to an Act authorizing the construction of the Winsted Water Works.

Resolved by this Assembly: SECTION 1. That the act authorizing the construction of the Winsted Water Works, passed May session, 1860, be, and the same is hereby, so amended as to fully empower the borough of Winsted to increase their supply of water by raising the embankment of the Little Pond—named in said act—to such height as may be desirable for the interests of said borough.

SEC. 2. All damages caused by reason of such increased height of embankment to be paid by said borough as provided in section five of said act.

SEC. 3. Such portions of section first of said act as limits the height of said embankment to four feet is hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act is to take effect from the day of its passage.
