CONCERNING SALARY OF DEPUTY JUDGE OF THE CITY COURT OF NORWICH.

Resolved by this Assembly: SECTION 1. That section two of the resolution relating to the city court of Norwich, fixing the salary of the deputy judge of said city court at eight hundred dollars per annum, passed at the May session of the legislature, 1876, and approved June twenty-eighth, 1876, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This resolution shall take effect upon and after its passage.

AMENDING THE RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE WINSTED WATER-WORKS.

Resolved by this Assembly: That a resolution authorizing the construction of the Winsted water-works, passed at the May session of the general assembly, A. D. 1860, and the amendments thereof, be altered and amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The board of water commissioners appointed under and by virtue of said resolution and its amendments, shall be restricted in their expenditures to the specific appropriations made by the borough of Winsted, at its annual meeting, and shall expend no moneys, and shall contract for no expenditures, except for the purposes and in the manner provided in such appropriations: *provided*, that if extraordinary needs shall require, additional expenditures may be made by and with the consent of two-thirds of the whole number of the board of warden and burgesses of said borough, and not otherwise.

SEC. 2. So much of said resolution and its amendments, authorizing the construction and maintenance of the said Winsted water-works, as is inconsistent with the foregoing section, is hereby repealed.
