

CAST IRON PIPES.

PROPOSALS will be received by the Mayor of the City of Washington, at his Office in the City Hall, until the 15th day of September next, for furnishing about 1700 feet, running measure, of Cast Iron Pipes of the best quality for conveying water. About 360 feet running measure, of the above length, to have a bore of 4 inches diameter, and the remainder, about 1340 feet, to have a bore of two and a quarter inches diameter. The proposals to state the price of each size per foot, running measure, completely fitted and laid in the ground; the price per running foot for the pipes only delivered in the city, and the time when the pipes can be delivered.

All the digging that will be necessary to complete the work, will be done by and at the expense of the Corporation, and is not to be included in the estimate of the cost of the pipes or the fixing of them.

As an inducement to proprietors of Foundries, &c. to make proposals for furnishing the above quantity of pipes, it is proper to observe, that if, on trial, they should be approved of, a large quantity will be required for conducting water through a large part of the City.
