1. An average of about 200 h. p. of exhaust steam is obtained from the Municipal Electric Lighting Plant, by special arrangement.
2. Comparatively few consumers are served by meter, the franchise of the company providing for only a flat rate. The meter rate is charged only when requested by, and under special agreement with the consumer. The higher rate is charged for the first 10,000 pounds used in any month, the rates varying from the higher to the lower by graduation, the lower rate being given for all over 300,000 pounds in any month. A discount or 10 per cent. is allowed from these rates in connection with important contracts for electric service for the same premises, this applying principally to stores or business houses using a great deal of electric light or power.
3. Under the terms of its franchise, the company is required to pay five per cent. of its gross receipts to the city, making the net rate to the company 28½ cents. The net meter rates are correspondingly reduced.
4. The rate was originally 17 cents, but on a satisfactory showing being made, that the rate was too low, a modified franchise was given the company by the city of Indianapolis, the rate being increased to 20 cents. The company is required to pay 5 per cent. of its gross receipts to the city, making the net rate 19 cents.
5. The lower rate applies when the full amount of radiation is installed, as required by the rules and regulations of the company; the higher rate applies to business houses only, when the full amount of radiation is not installed.
6. This capacity will be increased 60 per cent. during the present year.
7. This rate was originally 16½ cents.
