CHICAGO, ILL.

Dick Lee in Armstrong Trap Magazine of the Armstrong Machine Works, has this to say on kitchen equipment and processes at Hilton Center in this city. He says 5000 can be fed at one sitting in the banquet hall. “The meals are prepared in advance with helpings of meat, potatoes, vegetables, etc. placed on individual plates, and then quick frozen. The servings are held in the freezer until twenty-four hours prior to the banquet, when the plates with the servings are removed and placed in the steam heated warming cabinet for about 24 hours, until it is time for the meal to be served, when the waiters do so.

WARREN, OHIO

Republic Steel Corporation has installed and put into operation at its mill here more than a mile of wrapped stainless steel jacketed 12 in. steam line. The pipe will carry up to 200,000 lb of steam per hour at 550° F and a maximum of 225 psi. The extension is supported on posts above ground. Expansion is provided by pipe bends.
