

GAS COMPANY WILL LAY LARGER PIPE AT COLUMBUS AVE.

Informal Approval Given For Instalation of Steam Line

Members of the board of aldermen, in informal session today, entered into a gentleman's agreement relative to a permit to be given the Springfield Gas Light company to lay a 12-inch steam pipe under Columbus avenue near State street. The pipe will replace one of six inches now there and it is planned later to take formal action granting the permit.

The larger size of pipe is wanted to enable the company to furnish heat to a group of buildings other than those owned by the company. The steam plant is of sufficient capacity to take on the additional load and the steam pipes will now be increased accordingly.
