the seattle Steam Heat and Power Company for the supply of salt water in case of fire free of charge if the city will lay the mains, and let the company have the use of them, and also make connection between their pumps and the pay. Councilman Wat ingford objected. He thought the company should make their own connections. It will cost the city \$5.0 0. Councilman Twichell said that on all the property affected the rate of insurance would be reduced.

The ordinance was passed.

An ordinance was read contracting with
