

On motion of Mr. Holt, Resolved, That the resolution of the City Council, passed on the first day of March 1823, in relation to bringing water into the city, be from this time suspended; and the salary of the officer employed to act as engineer, with all other salaries, do immediately cease, and that a committee be appointed to receive the machinery with every thing belonging or appertaining to the same.

Resolved, That the committee upon the subject of bringing water into the city be instructed to take into consideration the letter of George M. Towers this day communicated to Council and report to Council at their next meeting, such contract or agreement as that letter contemplates and as the said committee shall approve.

Ordered, That the foregoing resolutions be published.
