

Columbus Water Works.—A meeting of the Columbus Water Works Company is to be held in the Superior Court room to-morrow (Tuesday) evening, at 7 p. m. We understand that a very favorable report will be submitted, showing the cost of the work, its probable revenue, and the progress of subscriptions. Contractors stand ready to execute the work at prices deemed unusually low, and Northern capitalists are willing to take a large amount of stock in pay for work and materials. It is estimated that these works will yield an income amounting to 14 or 15 per cent. on their cost, and that the saving to property holders in insurance alone, on account of their supply of water, will each year much more than repay the cost charged for water, which each family will be free to pay or not.
