

AT the trial of the Water Works last week, they failed to come up to the requirements of the contract between the city authorities and the Holly Co. The deficiency is in the machinery at the Water Works building. The Holly Company are adjusting it and will make the Works fill the requirements.

The contract requires three streams to be thrown to the height of one hundred feet. At the trial last week they reached about eighty feet, which would be amply sufficient to extinguish any fire that can occur in our City, but there will be no difficulty in making them throw water one hundred feet.

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
