SEALED proposals will be received by the Water Commissioners of the town of Bowling Green, Warren county, Kentucky, until September 5, 1868, for the construction of water works, comprising pumping engine, boiler, engine and boiler house, reservoir, 6,850 feet (lineal) of eight (8) inch pipe, 1,420 feet (lineal) of six (6) inch pipe, 4,705 feet (lineal) of four (4) inch pipe, 475 feet (lineal) of three (3) inch pipe, with hydrants, stop-gates, and all excavations and laying of said pipe.
