of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the third sentence, inserted by chapter 42 of the acts of 1970, and inserting in place thereof the following two sentences:- A licensee or his employee or agent shall carry only such weapons and equipment as are authorized by the commissioner; provided, however, that if said licensee, employee or agent, is authorized to carry a firearm, as defined in section one hundred and twenty-one of chapter one hundred and forty, said firearm shall be loaded while in the performance of his duties. A licensee, or his employee or agent, while in the performance of his duties, shall not carry an imitation firearm as defined in said section one hundred and twenty-one of said chapter one hundred and forty.

Chap. 117. AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME FOR ACCEPTANCE OF AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE ASH-FIELD WATER DISTRICT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 14 of chapter 267 of the acts of 1980 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 5, the word "four" and inserting in place thereof the word:- six.

(The foregoing was laid before the Governor on the fourteenth day of June, 1984 and after ten days it had "the force of a law", as prescribed by the Constitution, as it was not returned by him with his objections thereto within that time.)

Chap. 118. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chapter two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secretary may authorize in the manner set forth under said section thirty-nine, the solemnization of a marriage by Lawrence F. Warhall as he is a justice of the Derry district court of the state of New Hampshire, in the city of Waltham on July first, nineteen hundred and eighty-four between Sally A. Radlo of the city of Waltham and Louis V. Gaglini of the city of Waltham and
