AN ACT IN ADDITION TO AN ACT, ENTITLED, “AN ACT TO INCORPORATE SIMON LARNED & OTHERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONVEYING WATER BY PIPES INTO THE CENTRE OF THE TOWN OF PITTSFIELD, BY THE NAME OF THE PROPRIETORS OF THE WATERWORKS, IN THE MIDDLE OF THE TOWN OF PITTSFIELD.”

SEC. 1. *Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,* That the said Proprietors, or any three of them, may at any time, by advertisement posted up, at any two public houses in said Pittsfield, or published in a news paper printed in said Pittsfield, warn a meeting of said Proprietors, to be holden at such place in said Pittsfield, and at such time, not less than seven days from the posting up or publishing such advertisement, as shall be appointed and notified in the said advertisement; at which meeting so appointed & warned, any business expressed in such notification, and proper to be transacted by the said Proprietors, pursuant to the Act, entitled, “An Act to incorporate Simon Larned, and others for the purpose of conveying water by pipes, into the centre of the town of Pittsfield, by the name of The Proprietors of the Waterworks in the middle of the town of Pittsfield,” may be transacted.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the Corporate Officers of the said Proprietors last appointed, shall be and continue in their respective Offices, until a meeting for the appointment of Officers shall be warned and holden, in the manner authorised by this Act.
