IV. And be it enacted and ordained, That every owner of any carriage aforefaid, whole carriage shall not be numbered with black paint upon a white ground; in the centre of the middle pannel of each fide, and of the back, with plain and confpicuous figures of at least three inches in length, on or before the first day of April next, fhall forfeit and pay five dollars, for the use of the corporation, and a Penalry. like fum for every week fuch carriage fhall be employed for hire, and not numbered in the manner aforefaid.
