seventy-seven, as amended, relative to the appointment of assistant prosecuting attorneys for Wayne county, being compiler's section five hundred and sixty-one, third Howell's Annotated Statutes, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Prosecuting attorney to appoint assistants.

SECTION 1. That the prosecuting attorney of the county of Wayne is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint four assistant prosecuting attorneys for said county.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Alpena to raise money for the purchase of or the erection and maintenance of water-works.

Council to submit to vote proposition to borrow money for water-works.

SECTION 1. *The People of the State of Michigan enact,* That for the purpose of purchasing, establishing, erecting and maintaining water-works for the use of the city of Alpena, and the inhabitants thereof, the common council of said city is hereby authorized to submit to the electors of said city, at any special city election, a proposition to raise a sum of money, not exceeding one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, by a loan at a rate of interest not exceeding four per cent per annum, to be voted upon by ballot, in the manner provided for by act number one hundred seventy-eight of the session laws of eighteen hundred seventy-three.

Bonds may be issued if approved by two-thirds vote.

SEC. 2. If such proposition shall be approved by a two-thirds vote of said electors, present and voting, the common council of said city may, at any time thereafter, make such loan or so much thereof, as may be considered necessary, and issue the bonds of said city for the payment thereof, with the interest; said bonds to mature within twenty years from the date thereof.

Proceedings to be governed by act 178. of 1873.

SEC. 3. That all the proceedings in the matter of the purchase of property therefor, and of building and maintaining said water-works, not herein provided for, shall be in accordance with and in conformity to the provisions of said act number one hundred seventy-eight of the session laws of eighteen hundred seventy-three.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
