

CHAPTER 116.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF WINONA TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE WATER WORKS IN SAID CITY, AND TO OCCUPY CERTAIN PUBLIC GROUNDS THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The city of Winona is hereby authorized to construct on such portion of the public levee in the said city as it may designate for that purpose, or elsewhere in said city, pumping works and buildings for such works, and to operate and maintain the same for the purpose of furnishing a supply of water to said city.

SEC. 2. Such use of said levee is hereby declared a public use and made valid and legal.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 117.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF HENDERSON TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO REPAIR A CERTAIN HIGHWAY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That section twenty-three (23) of chapter forty-five (45) of the Special Laws of the year 1875, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subdivision, viz:

"*Twentieth*—The said council may also appropriate and expend such sum or sums of money not otherwise appropriated, as they may deem fit and proper, out of the treasury of said borough, for the purpose of maintaining and keeping in repair the public highway from and between the east end of the iron bridge across the Minnesota river at said borough, and the railroad depot at East Henderson."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
