CHAPTER 220.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT AND ADDITION TO AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE EXETER WATER-WORKS."

SECTION

1. Increased capital authorized.

SECTION

2. Takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

capital
authorized.

SECTION 1. For the purpose of extending its water-supply, mains, and service, and to provide means for paying for the same, together with additions already made to its system, as well as to provide means for cancelling its bonded and floating indebtedness, said Exeter Water-Works may from time to time increase its capital stock to an additional amount not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars; such increase to be made preferred, if desired, but in no event to an amount exceeding what is necessary to provide means for paying for said extensions and said indebtedness.

Takes effect.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

CHAPTER 221.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE CHESTER AND DERRY RAILROAD ASSOCIATION," APPROVED APRIL 7, 1891.

SECTION

1. May issue bonds.

SECTION

2. Takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

SECTION 1. Said corporation is authorized to issue bonds to the full amount of the capital stock paid in.

Takes effect.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
