CHAPTER 159.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE WORCESTER, NASHUA & ROCHESTER RAILROAD COMPANY TO ISSUE BONDS.

SECTION 1. Railroad may issue bonds ; conditions.	SECTION 2. Takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened :

Railroad may issue bonds ; conditions.

SECTION 1. The Worcester, Nashua & Rochester Railroad Company, a corporation established under the laws of the state of New Hampshire and the commonwealth of Massachusetts, is hereby authorized to issue bonds for the purpose of funding its floating debt, to an amount not exceeding outstanding at any time the sum of two hundred thousand dollars, payable in such way and manner as may be determined by the directors, and at any time not exceeding forty years from their dates, with interest payable semi-annually, and to secure the same by a first mortgage to trustees upon that part of its railroad lying between its terminus in the city of Nashua and its terminus in the city of Rochester in said state.

Takes effect.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

CHAPTER 160.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LANCASTER FIRE PRECINCT TO ISSUE BONDS.

SECTION 1. Precinct may issue bonds ; purpose. 2. Denominations and terms of bonds.	SECTION 3. Takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened :

Precinct may issue bonds ; purpose.

SECTION 1. The Lancaster fire precinct, of Lancaster, N. H., is hereby authorized to issue bonds, not exceeding in amount the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars, to provide for its indebtedness and to make extensions and improvements to the waterworks of said precinct.

The denominations and terms of bonds.

SECT. 2. Said bonds shall be issued in such denominations and upon such terms as provided by vote of said precinct at a meeting thereof duly called and holden April 10, 1894.

Takes effect.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
[Approved January 29, 1895.]
