## CHAPTER CLXXXII.

- A Supplement to an act entitled "An act for the construction, maintenance and operation of water works for the purpose of supplying cities, towns and villages of this state with water."
- 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey, That section one of the act entitled "An act for the construction, maintenance and operation of water works for the purpose of supplying cities, towns and villages of this state with water," which act was approved April twenty-first, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six, and which section reads as follows:
- "1. Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of Section to be the State of New Jersey, That any number of persons, not amended recited. less than seven, a majority of whom shall reside in this state, may form a company for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating water works in any city, town or village in this state, having a population of not more than fifteen thousand, and not less than two thousand inhabitants, and for the purpose of supplying such city, town or village and the inhabitants thereof with water," be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of company may be the State of New Jersey, That any number of persons, not formed for constructing, main less than seven, a majority of whom shall reside in this taining and oper state, may form a company for the purpose of constructworks. ing, maintaining and operating water works in any city, town, village or sea-side resort in this state, having a population of not more than fifteen thousand and not less than five hundred inhabitants, and for the purpose of supplying such city, town, village or sea-side resort and the inhabitants thereof with water.

## CHAPTER CLXXXIII.

A Supplement to an act entitled "An act to prevent fraudulent trusts and assignments," approved March seventh, one thousand eight hundred and fiftv.

Provisions of act 1. BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assertion by to apply to income of property, the State of New Jersey, That the provisions of the act to money, dec., held in trust for debt- which this is a supplement, and of all supplements are the income of all property, or thereto, shall apply to the income of all property, or money, or things in action held in trust for the debtor, where the trust has been created by, or the fund held in trust has proceeded from, some other person than the debtor himself; provided, the income of such trust property shall exceed four thousand dollars.
