CHAPTER CVIII.

A supplement to the act entitled "An act to incorporate the Hackettstown Aqueduct Company," approved March tenth, eighteen hundred and fifty-three.

Powers of
Company.

1. BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey*, That the president and directors authorized in the act to which this is a supplement, shall proceed to bring and convey into the town of Hackettstown, by means of pipes, conduits, forcing pumps or other machinery, water from the Musconetcong river, or from spring or springs, or stream or streams flowing from any springs, and take sufficient lands for the erection of proper works for conveying the same, also for the erection of proper cisterns or reservoirs, doing as little damage as possible and paying for the said water and lands, and governed by the same provisions as is provided for the digging of ditches and laying pipes or conduits through lands, in the eighth section of the act to which this is a supplement; *provided always*, that all lands now owned by Stephen Vail shall be exempted from and in no way subject to any of the provisions of this act.

Proviso.

Repealer.

2. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this supplement, be and the same are hereby repealed.

3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect immediately.
