word "security," in said section and inserting in the place thereof the word "deposit."

9. *And be it enacted*, That in case any member of the board of education of the city of Bayonne, shall, without cause satisfactory to a majority of said board, fail to attend four successive stated meetings of such board, such meetings not being held less than two weeks apart, his office as a member of said board shall, upon resolution of said board to that effect, be taken and deemed to be vacant, and the vacancy thus created shall be filled according to the provisions of the charter, in case of vacancies in said board.

When office of member of board of education deemed and taken to be vacant.

10. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall be deemed and taken a public act, and shall take effect immediately.

## CHAPTER CCCCLXII.

A supplement to the act to authorize the President and Directors of the Hackettstown Aqueduct Company to convey their works, and so forth, approved March seventeenth, one thousand eight hundred and seventy.

1. *BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey*, That the bonds hereafter issued, authorized in the act to which this is a supplement, shall be countersigned by the president of the water board.

Bonds issued to be countersigned by president.

2. *And be it enacted*, That the treasurer of the water board shall be authorized to pay the interest on the water bonds now issued, or may hereafter be issued, from moneys received from the town council, or from water rents; and that all moneys held by the said treasurer after paying interest and expenses, shall be held by him in trust for the final liquidation of the said water bonds, subject to investment by direction of the water commissioners.

Treasurer authorized to pay interest.

3. *And be it enacted*, That all moneys received by the treasurer shall be deposited in the Hackettstown bank, in the name of the treasurer of the board of water commissioners, subject to his draft upon the order of the president.

Moneys received to be deposited in Hackettstown bank.

**Repealer.** 4. *And be it enacted,* That all in the act to which this is a supplement, or any of the supplements thereto, inconsistent with this act, is hereby repealed.

5. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect immediately.

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### CHAPTER CCCCLXIII.

A further supplement to the act entitled, "An act to Revise and Amend the Charter of the City of Newark," approved March eleventh, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven.

Assess-

1. BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey,* That whenever the common council of the city of Newark shall ascertain the whole amount of the costs and expenses of constructing any sewer in said city not exceeding in its interior cross-section a circle of thirty-six inches diameter or its equivalent, with all the necessary appurtenances, they may by resolution either direct that the assessment of said costs and expenses shall be made by commissioners to be appointed by them for that purpose, or by the city surveyor, and said assessment shall then be made in accordance with the provisions of the charter of said city, and the supplements thereto, relating to the assessment of the costs, damages and expenses, or the costs and expenses, of constructing sewers by commissioners, or by the city surveyor as the case may be.

**Repealer.** 2. *And be it enacted,* That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed, and that this act shall be deemed and taken to be a public act and shall take effect immediately.
