## CHAPTER CLI.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT to "An act to authorize the construction of works for the supplying of Jersey City and the places adjacent with pure and wholesome water," approved March twenty-fifth, eighteen hundred and fifty-two.

1. BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey*, That the words "within the corporate limits of Jersey City," contained in section sixteen of a supplement to the act entitled "An act to authorize the construction of works for supplying Jersey City and places adjacent with pure and wholesome water," approved sixteenth of March, eighteen hundred and fifty-four, shall not be construed so as to prevent the water commissioners of Jersey City from expending any necessary moneys authorized to be raised and appropriated by the original act or supplement above mentioned upon any portion of the line of their works between the Passaic and Hudson rivers.

Commissioners may expend moneys on works between Passaic and Hudson rivers.

Approved March 16, 1859.
