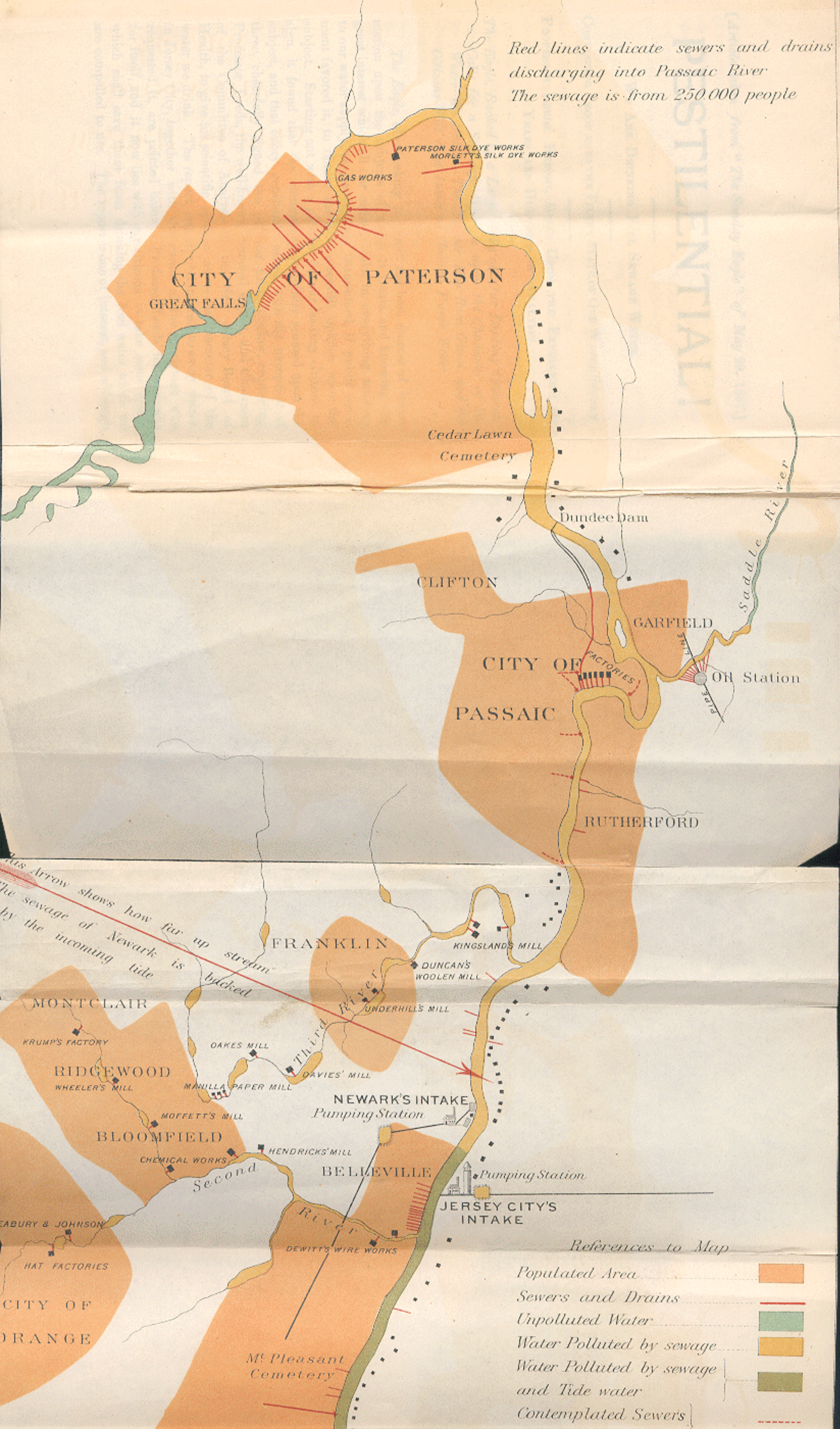


Red lines indicate sewers and drains

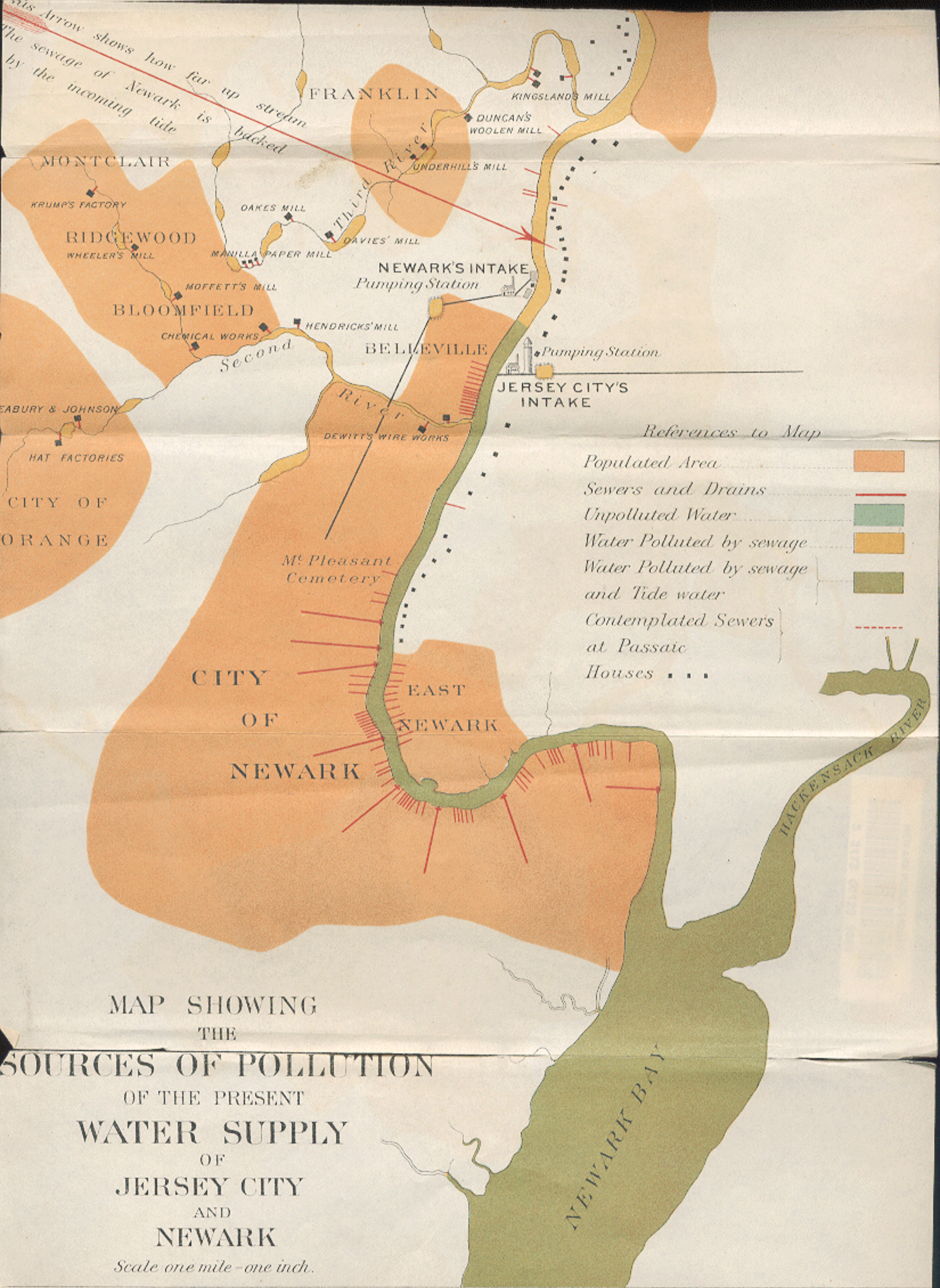
