## CHAPTER CCV.

A supplement to an act entitled "An act to incorporate the Mount Holly Water Company," approved April fifth, eighteen hundred and forty-five.

1. BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey*, That the capital stock of the Mount Holly Water Company, be and the same is hereby reduced to the sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars.

2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect immediately.

1. BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That Peter Smith, George W. Johnson, Richard Stephens, A. R. Day, William Shields, John Fisher, John Naughtright, J. H. Curtis, I. W. Crane, William L. Johnson, C. H. Valentine, John Tims, S. M. McClallen, and others, their associates, successors and assigns, shall be and are hereby ordained, constituted and declared to be a body corporate and politic, in fact and in name, by the name of "The Hackettstown Mutual Fire Insurance Company,"
