CHAPTER CCCXXIX.

A Supplement to an act entitled "An act to authorize the Construction of Works for supplying the City of Rahway and places adjacent with Pure and Wholesome Water," approved April seventh, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight.

Water com-
missioners
empowered
to collect wa-
ter rents
upon vacant
lots, &c.

1. BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey*, That the board of water commissioners of the city of Rahway, are hereby empowered to assess and collect water rents upon all vacant lots and lots with buildings thereon or any portion thereof, beyond and off the lines of streets in which water pipes are or may be laid, and to a distance not exceeding four hundred feet from the lines of such streets, and all the provisions of the original act to which this is a supplement and the supplement thereto relating to the assessment and collection of water rents upon property lying along any street in which water pipes are laid, shall also apply to the property liable to be assessed under this section; *provided*, that said commissioners may in their discretion fix and assess a different rate for any or all land lying off the line of said streets, from that fixed for land lying along the same.

Proviso.

2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect immediately.
