to the passage of this Act and remaining unpaid after the tax is levied for the year A. D. 1863, said pro ratio of said indebtedness to be determined by the amount of taxable property assessed in said counties for said year.

Repeal. SEC. 10. All laws and parts of laws conflicting with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 11. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAP. LXIII.—*An Act to supply the Town of Dayton, in Lyon County, with Water, and to protect the Town against fire, and to define the Boundaries thereof.*

[Approved February 20, 1864.]

Be it enacted, by the Governor and Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Nevada, as follows:

Franchise. SECTION 1. That Alfred James and his associates, their successors or assigns, are hereby granted the exclusive right for the term of ten years, to lay distributing water pipes in any of the public streets or alleys of the Town of Dayton; *Provided*, said pipes shall be so laid down as not to interfere or obstruct the public thoroughfares of said town.

Boundaries. SEC. 2. The boundaries of said Town of Dayton are hereby declared to be as follows, to wit: Commencing on the head of Main street, where it crosses the ditch, and running thence in a southerly direction half a mile; thence easterly one mile, thence northerly one mile, thence westerly one mile, thence southerly half a mile to the place of beginning.

Water rates. SEC. 3. The rate, price, or sum of money to be charged for the use of water furnished to parties in said town by the said Alfred James and his associates and successors, shall be whatever price may be agreed upon by the parties using the same and the said Alfred James and his associates and successors.

To complete in one year. SEC. 4. It shall be the duty of the said Alfred James, and his associates and successors, to commence said work within one year, and to complete the same so far as supplying persons with water on Main street, who desire to use it, within two years.

Free. SEC. 5. Fire companies, for the purpose of putting out fires in the Town of Dayton, shall be furnished water free of charge.

Right of town to purchase. SEC. 6. The town of Dayton shall have the right at any time after the expiration of five years from the completion of the work, on giving six months notice of their intention, to purchase all the works and franchises hereby granted, which may be in use in supplying water to the people of said town, the value to be determined by two Commissioners, selected by the said Alfred James and his associates or successors, two by the Town of Dayton, and one selected by the four Commissioners aforesaid.

SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.
