

hereby authorized and empowered to fill in with earth the space embraced within the above limits, and to have, use, occupy and enjoy the same as the property of the said company, in as full and ample a manner to all intents, uses and purposes of the said company, as they now hold, use, occupy and enjoy any other property belonging to the said company.

§ 2. The company are hereby authorized and empowered ^{Toll-house.} to remove the toll-house near the said bridge, from its present location, if they shall deem it expedient so to do, and to place it upon the ground so to be wharfed out by virtue of the provisions of the first section of this act.

§ 3. Such parts of the act hereby amended, as may be in- ^{Repeal.} consistent with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

CHAP. 37.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act to incorporate the proprietors of the Albany Water Works.

Passed March 11, 1844, by a two-third vote.

The People of the State of New-York, represented in Senate Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. The trustees and company of the Albany Water Works, are hereby authorized to increase their capital stock ^{Stock may be increased.} by an additional amount of fifty thousand dollars.

§ 2. Such additional stock shall be divided into one thousand ^{To be divided into shares.} shares of fifty dollars each; and may be issued from time to time in such portions as the trustees of said company shall see fit.

§ 3. Whenever the said trustees shall see fit to issue the ^{And sold by auction.} whole or any part of the said additional stock, they shall cause the same to be sold by public auction for the benefit of the said company.

CHAP. 38.

AN ACT for the relief of the State Prison at Auburn.

Passed March 12, 1844.

The People of the State of New-York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. The sum of five thousand three hundred and three ^{Appropriation of \$3,000.} dollars and eighty cents is hereby appropriated for the use
