## Chap. 12.

AN ACT relating to the city of Auburn, and to amend the charter thereof.

Passed February 19, 1864; three-fifths being present.

*The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. Title six, section one, of an act entitled "An act to revise the charter of the city of Auburn," passed April eighteen, eighteen hundred and fifty-one, as the same has been heretofore amended, is hereby further amended by inserting after the words "contingent expenses of said city," the words "and also the further sum of two thousand dollars, for the purpose of procuring a supply of water for the use and protection of said city, as contemplated by section sixteen, of the act entitled 'An act to incorporate the Auburn water works company,' passed April nineteen, eighteen hundred and fifty-nine."

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
