Chap. 85.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled an act to amend an act entitled "An act to incorporate the Buffalo water works company," passed March fifteenth, eighteen hundred and forty-nine.

Passed March 26, 1861.

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Hereafter the annual election for the directors of the Buffalo water works company shall be held on the third Wednesday of May, at such time of day and place in the city of Buffalo, as the directors for the time being shall appoint, giving at least four weeks public notice of said meeting.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Chap. 86.

AN ACT authorizing and providing for the transfer of certain actions and proceedings from the city court of Brooklyn, to the supreme court.

Passed March 26, 1861, three-fifths being present.

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Whenever any action or proceeding shall be commenced, or pending in the city court of Brooklyn, or before the city judge of Brooklyn, in which the said city judge shall have acted in the capacity of an attorney or as counsel, or shall be interested, or in which he would be excluded as a juror, by reason of consanguinity or affinity to either of the parties, the said judge shall make a certificate, stating such fact, and file
