

Compromised.

The suit of the Holly Water Works Company against the village of Dunkirk has been compromised by the parties. The suit was to recover \$5,000 in bonds withheld by the Board of Water Commissioners for the village as a security against damages in the works, and about \$3,900 and interest in cash claimed as due them as balance on contract and for extra work. The matter was compromised on Tuesday by the village agreeing to deliver the bonds and paying \$2,500, of which \$2,000 will be in additional bonds, each party paying its own costs. By this settlement the entire cost of the water works with the original ten miles of pipe is \$100,000, the amount of the original contract. \$2,000 has been paid for additional one-third of a mile of pipe, and \$500 for certain work on the machinery which the Holly company claimed was for improvements and the Board claimed was for repairs.
