The under-signed having just completed and put into successful operation a set of the Holly Water Works for the village of Norwalk, Ohio, would respectfully make this proposition to the Citizens of Jamestown. I will furnish the Machinery, Pipe, Hydrants, Building and every thing else complete (except lot and right of way), ready to be put into use to the satisfaction of the citizens—or the city may furnish everything and I will superintend the construction of Works, lay the pipe and guarantee the successful working of the same. The style of works to correspond as near as practicable with those in operation here, a full description of which will be given in the Journal if desired; but I would prefer that a committee be sent to inspect them, asking that a portion of said committee be *opposed to works*. I also am pleased to refer your citizens to A Kent, Esq., who has seen our Works in operation.
