Mr. Robt N. Marvin then presented the following petition.

WATER WORKS.

We, Heuben E. Fenton, Robert Newland, Geo. W. Tew, Robert N. Marvin, Lucius B. Warner, Frank E. Gifford and Wm. C. J. Hall, all of the Village of Jamestown, in the County of Chautauqua and State of New York, propose to form a Water Works Company under and by virtue of chapter 30 of the laws of 1873, Passed June 19, 1873, entitled "An act in relation to the creation and formation of water-works companies in towns and villages of the State of New York, for the purpose of supplying the said Village of Jamestown and the inhabitants thereof with pure and wholesome water. The proposed capital stock of said company is one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, to be divided into three hundred shares of five hundred dollars each, transferable only on the books of the Company. Water is to be supplied from Chesadaga Creek or from Chautauqua Lake or the outlet thereof near the boatlanding in said village, or from wells sunk near said boatlanding, or on the flats near said Village or between Palmer's Mill and said Chesadaga Creek.

We, the undersigned, the said persons who propose to form said company, therefore request the proper authorities in the premises, under said act, to consider this the application of said company to supply said village and the inhabitants thereof with pure and wholesome water.
