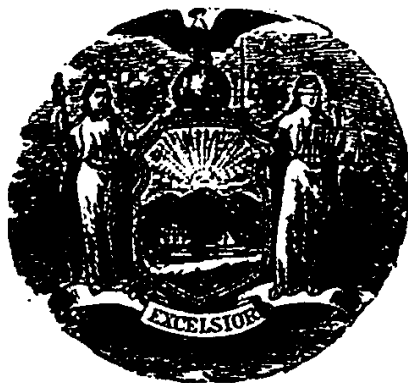

leges under this act; provided its said full number shall be filled within thirty days after said company shall be required so to do by the said board of trustees.

§ 6. Each of said fire companies shall have the right to pass by-laws By-laws. for its own government, not inconsistent with the by-laws, rules and regulations established by the said board of trustees and the laws of this State.

§ 7. The said fire department shall possess the general powers of a General powers of corporation. corporation as defined and limited in title three of the eighteenth chapter of part first of the Revised Statutes of this State, and shall be subject to the provisions of such act so far as they may be applicable to said department, and the organization thereof, and so far as the same are not inconsistent with this act.

§ 8. The said board of trustees shall have power to impose reason- Imposi- tion of fines and penalties. ble fines and penalties for violation by members of said corporation of the by-laws, rules and regulations of said board, and to sue in the corporate name for the recovery of such penalties.

§ 9. This act shall take effect immediately.

Chap. 161.

AN ACT amendatory of chapter one hundred and fifty-six of the laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, incorporating the Malone Water-Works Company, and authorizing said company to increase its capital stock and to contract with the village of Malone for a supply of water.

PASSED April 21, 1886; three-fifths being present.

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two of the act entitled "An act to incorporate the Malone Water-Works Company," is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 2. The capital stock of said company shall be fifteen thousand Capital stock. dollars, and shall be divided into shares of fifty dollars each, but may at any time be increased by the directors of the company, provided that said capital stock shall not be increased so as to exceed the sum of two hundred thousand dollars.

§ 2. Section seventeen of the said act of incorporation is hereby repealed, and the following is hereby enacted as a substitute therefor:

§ 17. All contracts for water supply between the village of Malone, Contracts with vil- lage for water supply. incorporated under the general law, and the said Malone Water-Works Company shall be made under the provisions of section seven, title four, chapter two hundred and ninety-one of the laws of eighteen hundred and seventy as amended, and such contract shall, in their creation and in all other respects, be controlled and regulated by all the provisions of said title four which are relevant to said contracts.

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
