

Monhagen Lake.

The water of Monhagen is now more than twenty feet deep, and the height of the surface above the main pipe is $14\frac{1}{2}$ feet. It is three feet lower than the highest mark this year, when the depth down to the main pipe was 17 feet 6 inches, and this depth was the greatest the lake had attained within three years. The greatest depth last summer, down to the main pipe, was 12 feet and 6 inches. One time last October there were only 9 inches of water above the main pipe, and a general work of shutting off was done in the village. In eight days after the shutting off, Superintendent Sproat found that the surface was twenty-three inches above the pipe.
