## CHAP. 335.

### AN ACT *relative to the State Prison at Mount Pleasant.*

Passed May 14, 1845.

*The People of the State of New-York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

§ 1. The agent of the state prison at Mount Pleasant, is hereby authorized to procure for the use of said prison a supply of water from the Croton aqueduct, and for that purpose to contract with the common council of the city of New-York, upon such terms and conditions as shall be sanctioned by the governor and comptroller of this state. Supply of water to be procured.

§ 2. The said agent is hereby authorized to enter upon any land or water for the said purpose, or for the purpose of making surveys ; and with approbation of the comptroller to agree with the owner or owners of any property which may be required for the purposes of this act, as to the amount of compensation to be paid to said owner or owners. Land may be procured

§ 3. In cases of disagreement between the said agent and the owner or owners of any property which may be required for the said purpose, or be affected by any operation connected therewith, as to the amount of compensation to be paid to such owner or owners ; or in case any such owner shall be an infant, married woman, insane, or absent from the state, the circuit judge of the second circuit may appoint three suitable persons, neither of whom shall be a resident of the county of Westchester, to examine such property and to estimate the value thereof, or the damage thus sustained, and report thereon to the said circuit judge, who may confirm, modify, or wholly reverse the same. Provision in case of disagreement.

§ 4. The sums thus awarded, and all other sums necessary to carry the foregoing provisions into effect, shall be paid by the agent of said prison, and he shall keep and render a particular account of all sums expended for the purposes aforesaid. Money to be paid.

§ 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
