
MEDINA PEAT.—It is said that peat is being dug a short distance from Medina, and taken to that village and sold at \$7,50 per ton. The parties engaged in digging cannot supply the demand. The specimen of peat we have seen from Medina is light and grassy. It will take a much larger pile for a ton than of the Bloomfield peat, and we think the consumption would be much more rapid.
