## Chap. 207.

AN ACT to ratify, legalize and confirm the proceedings of "The Rochester Water Works Company."

Passed April 16, 1868 ; three-fifths being present.

Preamble.

*Whereas*, The Rochester Water Works Company was duly incorporated by an act of the Legislature of the State of New York, passed April sixteenth one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two, and

*Whereas*, The said company has from time to time elected and appointed officers and directors, as vacancies occurred, and has entered into contracts for the building and management of the said Rochester Water Works; Therefore,

*The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

Acts of water-works company confirmed.

SECTION 1. All the acts, elections, appointments to office, and contracts heretofore done, held or made by said company, with the view to carry out the object specified in said charter, to furnish pure water to the city of Rochester, are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Election of officers confirmed.

§ 2. That the election and appointments of the present officers of said Rochester Water Works Company, be and the same are hereby confirmed.

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

## Chap. 208.

AN ACT to authorize the village of Groton to remove the dead from the burying grounds in said village to the cemetery, and to authorize said village to hold the old burying grounds or sell the same, and to purchase a piece of land.

Passed April 16, 1868.
