**WATER WORKS.**—We now and then hear something of the progress of the Rochester Water Works through outside sources. The latest is from a Honeoye Falls correspondent of the Lima Recorder, who says:

The Rochester Water Works Company are actively engaged at the present headquarters of the works, on the farm of Alfred Gates, to let the water from Honeoye creek into the pipes, and this can be done with the completion of the reservoir at Henrietta. And now the people of that beautiful and flourishing city will soon be supplied with fresh water from these beautiful lakes—Hemlock and Honeoye—running direct ~~from the source to the city~~ and through seventeen miles of hemlock pipe.

This all sounds good, but let not our citizens make too much preparation for water at present. Many of the mill owners below the point where Honeoye creek is to be tapped have secured the services of lawyers, and are prepared to place injunctions on the company at the moment they propose to take the water. These parties will contest the right of the water company to divert the stream or any portion from their mills.
