
A WATER COMMISSION.—Mr. George D. Lord has introduced to the Assembly a bill to create a Commission to supply water to this city. The Commissioners will be nominated by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate. The provisions of the bill are similar to those in the bill introduced last session. As it is clear that the people of this city will never agree upon any water plan it is well enough to leave the whole matter to a good Commission. We must do this or go on for thirty years longer without water. The way is now clear to go at the work of obtaining a supply of water. The franchise of the old company is extinct and there is no longer a dog in the manger. Rochester had better construct water works herself through a Commission than hire a company to build such works and control them for all time.
