

Electric Light Company's Bridge.

Yesterday the Edison Electric Light Company's new bridge across the canal from its plant on Edison street to the foot of Aqueduct street was completed. The structure will be used exclusively for the support of the heavy mass of electric wires at that point. The weight of the bridge is thirty-five tons, and its height will be twenty-one feet above the canal. It was constructed by the Rochester Bridge and Iron Works under the supervision of John F. Alden; the work of erection yesterday afternoon was superintended by Edmond W. Merrill of the bridge works.
