this act, in reference to the establishment of academical departments, shall be as applicable to those school districts or villages where free schools have been established, by special charter, as if no such charter had been granted; but nothing in this act shall be construed to impair the charters or alter or abridge the rights or privileges of any free schools now by law established in any city of the state.

§ 19. This act shall take effect immediately.

## Chap. 434.

AN ACT to revive and amend chapter ninety-six, Laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-one, entitled "An act to incorporate the Rome Water Works Company."

Passed June 18, 1853.

The People of the State of New - York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. Chapter ninety-six, Laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-one, entitled "An act to incorporate the Rome Water Works Company," is hereby revived and re-enacted, and all the provisions of said act are hereby declared to be in full force; and any corporation to be hereafter organized, under said act, shall have all the rights and privileges secured to them by said act.

§ 2. Section one of said act is hereby amended so as to read as follows : Bloomfield J. Beach, Horace Adams, John Stryker, Edward Huntington, Enoch B. Armstrong, Roland S. Doty, Calvert Comstock, Hervey Brayton and John B. Jervis, and all such persons as are or may be hereafter associated with them, shall be and are hereby constituted a body corporate by the name of the Rome Water Works Company.

§ 3. Section five of said act is hereby amended by striking out the words "one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two, and inserting instead thereof the words "one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four."

§ 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
