And be it further enacted, That in the event of the death of Governor to any one or more of the said commissioners, or refusal to act, it shall be lawful for the governor of this state to supply any vacancy which may occur as aforesaid, by the appointment of such judicious freeholder or freeholders not interested in the premises as he may think fit and proper, who on such appointment shall be empowered to discharge all the duties of commissioners under and by virtue of this

AN ACT for the relief of the Trustees of the Schenectady Water Works.
