said company is laid opposite thereto, or within one hundred yards of said pipe, and that the president and managers shall have power to collect the said protection tax as debts are now collected by the laws of this commonwealth; and that the said board of managers shall have the right to make such abatements and exonerations as to them may seem just and reasonable: *Provided*, That each protection tax shall not exceed the sum of five dollars on a front not exceeding thirty feet: *And provided further*, That no such protection tax shall be levied and assessed upon lots whose owners or occupiers pay water rents for the use of said lots of the water furnished by the said company: *Provided*, That said corporation shall pay into the treasury of the commonwealth such bonus and taxes as are now or may hereafter be required by law.

A Supplement

To an act, entitled "An Act to authorize the burgess and town council of the borough of Lehigh, Carbon county, to borrow money," approved the twenty-fourth day of March, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That the burgess and town council of the borough of Lehigh, in the county of Carbon, or their successors in office, be and they are hereby empowered to borrow an additional sum of money to that authorized to be borrowed in the act to which this is a supplement, not to exceed the sum of ten thousand dollars, upon the conditions and in the manner provided by said act.
