A further Supplement

To an act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Scranton Gas and Water Company," approved March sixteenth, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four.

WHEREAS, The Scranton Gas and Water Company were, by law, authorized to borrow seventy thousand dollars :

And whereas, The said company have issued and disposed of their bonds to that amount, and have also made, executed and delivered to John Brisbin and George L. Dickson, a mortgage in trust, to secure the payment of seventy thousand dollars of bonds, as therein set forth, which is recorded in Luzerne county, and have sold fifty thousand dollars of the bonds thereby secured; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,

That the said bonds and mortgage, and all acts and things done by the officers of the said Scranton Gas and Water Company, in pursuance of the direction of the board of directors of said company, connected with, or relating to, the issuing, disposing of and securing the payment of said bonds, are hereby made lawful and valid, and obligatory upon said company; and that it shall be lawful for said company to dispose of the remaining twenty thousand dollars of the bonds secured by said mortgage, for the purpose of taking up the outstanding bonds of said company that are not thus secured.
